Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2010 (the next generation of SharePoint (current release is SharePoint 2007)) is expected to be available toward the middle of this year and with the public release of the Beta code in December (2009), organizations have had a opportunity to see SharePoint 2010.

- What’s new in terms of SharePoint 2010 search including the new “FAST Search” technology integrated into SharePoint 2010
- How Office 2010 expands on the collaboration and communication enhancements in SharePoint 2010
- Recommendation to organizations with SharePoint 2007 on what they can do to prepare for a future migration to SharePoint 2010
